The Renfrew County Community Development Fund provides non-repayable funding to support community economic development projects up to 50% of eligible project costs to a maximum of \$4,000. The grant supports projects that:

- address strategic economic development priorities;
- support the business community;
- have a significant, measurable impact;
- demonstrate collaboration with community economic development partners;
- support community capacity for economic development.

Funding is limited, not all eligible projects will be approved. We encourage potential

applicants to contact our office to discuss their potential project prior to completing an application.


